


Fall Foliage at Yonago Great Falls

<p>Overview</p>	<p>Yonago Great Falls, one of Japan's Top 100 waterfalls, is a spectacle with two falls (Fudo Falls, 85m high, and Gongen Falls, 75m) cascading down tumultuously into a serene valley side by side.</p> <p>Fudo Falls have been known to Shinto ascetics as the site of purification rites since antiquity. Even now, you can have a close look at ascetics performing purification, standing under the waterfalls.</p> <p>October is a peak season for fall colors, when restrictions are imposed on private vehicles, and shuttle bus services are provided for a fee.</p> <p>There is a walking tour of the waterfalls on Saturday, October 18, when you can hike the 3km-course to the falls with a tour guide.</p>

<p>Access</p>	<p>Taxi: About a 50-min. (17 km) ride from Suzaka Station on Nagano Dentetsu Electric Railway to the parking. Car: About a 50-min. drive (19km) from the Suzaka-Nagano Exit to the parking</p>
