

Grape Picking



Suzaka City is one of Japan's largest producers of *Kyoho*, the king of grapes. It is because of Suzaka's good soil, large temperature difference between day and night, and low precipitation. Please also try Nagano Purple and Shine Muscat grapes which are seedless and soft-skinned.

You can enjoy many kinds of grape picking from mid-August to late October.
