

Fruit Picking at the Foot of Mt. Asama



Pick blueberries and apples, enjoying cool, fresh winds at the foot of Mt. Asama, in the highland farm at 1,000m above sea level. There are over 15 species of 2,000 blueberry trees and 20 species of 2,000 apple trees grown organically with lots of sunshine. You can also enjoy BBQ and pond-fishing.
