

Grape and Apple Picking in Iiyama



Please enjoy grape and apple picking at Shiozaki Farm, only a seven-minute walk from the Madarao Exit of Iiyama Station on the Hokuriku Shinkansen line.

The grape picking season is from late August to October, and the following varieties are available in this order during the season: Niagara, Campbell, Kyoho, seedless Kyoho, Pione, and Steuben.

The apple picking season is from September to late November. The available varieties are: Sun Tugaru, Akibae, Kogyoku, Sekai Ichi, Yoko, Shinano Sweet, Shinano Gold, Orin, and Sun Fuji in this order.

In Shiozaki Farm, you can pick the best variety in its best season. There is no time limit, and they provide everything you need to pick fruit.

Please drop by the farm while you wait for the next Shinkansen train.
