

Journey to a Beautiful Sunset Point by Electric Bicycle

Mt. Iizuna park, located on a plateau above Komoro city, offers beautiful views, forest strolls, bird-watching, an art museum and more.

The sunsets in the autumn months are especially gorgeous. Mt. Iizuna park is known as Komoro's top sunset spot, and from the ruins of Fujimi castle you can gaze upon Mt. Asama, the Yatsugatake and Tateshina mountains, the distant Northern Alps and even Mt. Fuji! To reach the park, we recommend renting an electric bicycle to make easy work of Komoro's hills. Pedal towards the golden sunset while enjoying fresh highland air.
